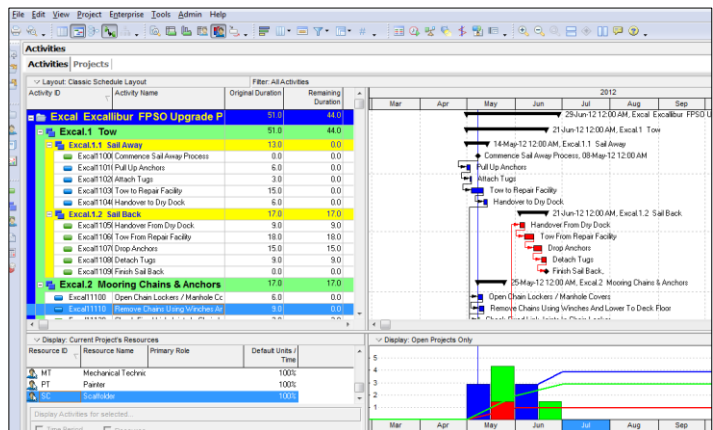
Course topics are as per the 3-day course but omitting the discussions concerning planning theory and principles of best practice, instead concentrating on more practical “hands on” learning.
